2025 Treasurer

Physical & Health Education Canada (PHE Canada) is currently seeking a dedicated and detail-oriented individual to serve as Treasurer on our Board of Directors.

As Treasurer, you will play a key role in supporting the financial health and sustainability of the organization. Working closely with the Executive Director and Finance & Audit Committee, the Treasurer provides oversight of financial reporting, budgeting, and risk management to guide strategic decision-making.

Key Responsibilities:

- Oversee and present budgets, financial reports, and statements to the Board.
- Monitor the organization's financial performance and ensure compliance with policies and regulations.
- Chair or participate in the virtual Finance & Audit Committee.
- Review, recommend, and approve financial policies.
- Ensure the accuracy and integrity of financial reports and plans.
- Attend 3 virtual quarterly Board meetings and 1 in-person meeting (spring).
 Up to \$1,000 travel bursary is available; all additional costs to participate must be self-funded.
- Review the agenda and supporting materials before each Board meeting.
- Present and approve annual budgets and audit reports.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Professional experience in financial management, accounting, finance, or related fields.
 (CPA designation is an asset, but not required)
- Vulnerable sector and background check/screening.
- Previous Board experience or understanding of nonprofit governance.
- Commitment to the mission and values of PHE Canada.

Term: The successful candidate will begin their term in November 2025, following appointment at PHE Canada's Annual General Meeting. The role includes the possibility of annual reappointment.

Location: The Treasurer role can be fulfilled from anywhere in Canada. While PHE Canada's headquarters are located in Ottawa, Ontario, Board participation is fully supported remotely.

Salary: This is a volunteer position.
