Definitions

 _Sac of skin that holds the testicles just underneath the penis
 _Two glands on either side of bladder that secrete seminal fluid
 _Two oval shaped organs contained in the scrotum, which produce the hormone testosterone and sperm (also called the testes)
 _The tube-like sex organ which hangs outside of the body
 _A gland near the bladder that adds fluid to semen
 _The tube that at different times carries urine and semen out of the body
 _The thin long tubes through which sperm travel from the testicles, and where sperm are mixed with other fluid to make semen
 _A sac inside the abdomen that holds urine
 _The skin around the head of an uncircumcised penis
