School Activities



1. School-Wide Survey: The Student Action Team created and distributed a school-wide survey to better understand the needs that needed to be addressed when it comes to smoking and vaping. The results of the survey indicated that about 35% of the student population were vaping.

2. Installation of Halo Vape Detectors: The STOMP Student Action Team purchased eight Halo vape detectors which are installed in the school bathrooms where vaping is most prevalent. The goal of installing these devices was to reduce the number of students vaping in school bathrooms, and as a byproduct, make them healthier and safer spaces for all students.



3. Morning Announcements/Bulletin Boards: The Student Action Team developed a series of short TikTok-style PSA announcements educating students and staff about the negative effects of vaping/smoking. Students also created an informative bulletin board which provided education around substance use, harm reduction, and upstream prevention.





- 4.** **School-Wide Assemblies:** The Student Action Team led activities during monthly assemblies that educated the student body on the negative effects that vaping/smoking have on their health. Next year, the students will incorporate interactive games that touch on all areas of wellness but will have more focus on the health risks of vaping/smoking.

- 5.** **“No Vaping” Stickers:** The Student Action Team also created “No Vaping” stickers and put them up in high traffic areas such as hallways, stairwells, and bathrooms. Stickers were also put up in the school buses which was noted as another environment where vaping also occurred quite frequently.



Sustainability Plan

The STOMP program continues at Nackawic High School:

- Next year the students intend to deliver an educational session with the new grade 9's as part of their kick-off day in September.
